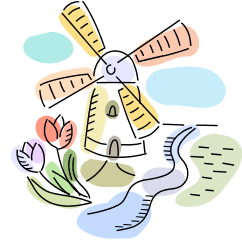


Tulip Time Festival

The Holland Tulip Time Festival stage a world class festival and popular events for area residents and visitors that showcase the community and the tulips and celebrate Dutch heritage and culture.

A word of caution: The day will be long and there will be a lot of walking. We have a very full day planned. There will plenty of places to rest.

Our day starts pretty early as we depart for about a three hour ride to Holland. **A continental breakfast** will be served on the motor coach and a stop will be made along the way at a rest area.

Itinerary

#1 - deBoer's Dutch Bros. Bakkerij deBoer's is a full service European style bakery with 200 years of baking experience. This will be our first stop so that you may indulge in some authentic Dutch baked goods before lunch.

#2 - Windmill Island This beautiful oasis features a 248 year old Dutch windmill and over 150,000 tulips in bloom in the spring. This is where we will have an authentic Dutch lunch. After lunch there will be time for you to explore the miniature Netherlands Village with all its quaint shops.

#3 - Dutch Marktplaats Experience the tastes, sights, sounds and crafts of 19th Century Holland as you stroll through a piece of yesteryear. Dutch food, folk dancing, period crafts, costumes and activities add up to a memorable experience right in the heart of downtown Holland.

#4 - Nelis Dutch Village Here we will take a step back into the Netherlands of over 100 years ago with authentic Dutch architecture, flowering gardens, canals and windmills. There will also be many events taking place throughout the day as well for a true Dutch experience.

#5 - Veldheer Tulip Gardens, DeKlomp Wooden Shoe & Delft Factory Veldheer's is Holland's only tulip farm perennial garden. Its continuous parade of color is made of over 5 million tulips as well as daffodils, hyacinths and crocus. Flowers are not the only thing to enjoy. There is also the wooden shoe and delft factory as well as their herd of American Bison to see.

#6 - Beechwood Inn Restaurant Our last stop is the Beechwood Inn for a family style dinner. The menu includes slow cooked ribs, savory chicken bake and their famous perch, two kinds of potatoes, a vegetable, salad, dessert and beverages. Their famous fried mushrooms and onion rings are served as appetizers.
