

Dearborn Heights Parks & Recreation Department presents the 2021 Summer Recreation Program beginning Monday, June 14,2021 through Friday, August 13, 2021. Program runs Monday through Friday from 10:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Located at Central Park, 1800 Kinloch, Dearborn Heights. Anyone going into grades 1st through 5th in the fall can participate. Must provide child's most current report card as proof of grade. This program is weather permitting.

Daily activities include arts & crafts, organized games, sports, drama activities, etc. at Central Park. Weekly special events such as: Putt-Putt Golf, Bowling, Roller-skating, Swimming, Parties and Picnics require transportation and additional fees.

The fee is \$ 250.00 per Dearborn Heights resident child, \$100.00 per each additional resident child living in the same household. It is \$275.00 per non-resident (There is no family rate for non-residents). Residents must show proof of residency (Driver's License) Registration for Dearborn Heights Residents begins Monday, April 5, 2021 and non-residents can register after Monday, May 3, 2021. Space is limited due to site restrictions, so it is first come, first serve.

Registration can be done at the Canfield Community Center and the Richard A. Young Recreation Center. Make checks payable to City of Dearborn Heights. Visa, MasterCard, and Discover cards accepted. Online registration available for a nominal convenience fee. First time online registrants must make an account at Dearborn Heights
